I was hired to scan all images, create FPOs, review for print quality and organize all incoming images submitted by the author. It wasn't long before I streamlined several processes.

For example:

- Developed new procedures, such as digital PDF delivery to the author rather than printing drafts and shipping the book for review and corrections.
- Introduced Photoshop image batching automation for FPOs, dramatically improving the number of images processed and turn around time for designers and authors.

This gave me the opportunity to grow, and I quickly advanced to photo editor, visual asset manager, and Pre-press supervisor. Along with these responsibilities, I assisted the art director in managing catalog and web page updates. This is where my passion and love for graphic design flourished.
